On both occasions his aircraft was badly damaged but he succeeded in bringing it back to 8 Squadron's aerodrome. 16/04/18 Awarded a Bar to his MC for conspicuous gallantry in action when his FK8 Serial C3678 was severely damaged by anti-aircraft fire (fuel tank and wings), with his observer having to climb out on to the wing to help him steer the crippled aircraft back across the lines and make a successful crash-landing. 27/05/18 Wounded in the neck by anti-aircraft fire when on a mission in a AW FK8 in France and was returned to England on a hospital ship to recuperate. He did not recover in time to return to active service in WW1. 15/10/18 "Mentioned in Despatches". ??/??/19 Posted to 123 Squadron, based in Russia. 16/08/20 Whilst serving with 2 Squadron at Fermoy, Ireland, he injured his hand when his Bristol Fighter H1448 suffered engine failure during a mail flight and crashed. 16/05/22 Whilst serving with 6 Squadron in Baghdad, Iraq, engine failure in his Bristol Fighter D7845 due to a petrol blockage caused him to crash and he was killed.</p>
